


HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

We present a lot of useful information in this 2016 edition of the Golf Guide. At first glance it might be a bit overwhelming. Here are some tips on how to make the most of it.



PIN LOCATION •-

Use this color key and the overhead views on the right to choose your desired pin location.


TEE SELECTION •-

Chose your tee position based of one of the following criteria:

RATING: Useful for scratch golfers, rating identifies the difficulty of a course for a particular tee. The higher the rating, the more difficult the course will play.

SLOPE: Useful for bogey golfers, slope helps measure the difficulty of a course for a particular tee. The higher the slope, the more difficult the course will play for an average bogey golfer compared to a par or scratch golfer.

DRIVE: Choose your tee based on your average driver distance. For example if you typically hit your driver 220 yards off the tee, we suggest you play from the white tee.



COURSEYARDAGE •

This table details yardage by hole, front and back nine, and overall total, for the novice pin location. Quickly compare how your tee selection will influence the length of a course.












































Bay Harbor Golf Club

The Links course was the first to open for play in 1996. It also holds the distinction of being the most expensive nine hole golf course ever built at the time. Initially described as something that belonged in science fiction, the barren landscape looked like it could have been part of the lunar landscape. Most of the unexpected cost involved the kiln dust left from the former cement plant, particularly on holes two and seven. Closely following the shoreline, The Links is meant to evoke the feeling of a Scottish style course and highlight the magnificence of Lake Michigan.

The Quarry is Bay Harbor Golf Club's diamond in the rough and the last course completed. The ruggedness of an existing quarry was preserved to give The Quarry a rough, industrial edge designed to finish in a dramatic style. It is considered to be one of the most unique courses you can play and is a visual delight. It finishes with dramatic flair down to and along the shores of Lake Michigan with some of the most picturesque finishing holes that you'll find anywhere.



Bethpage State Park is one of the most popular and cherished public parks in the nation. Located in suburban Long Island in close proximity to New York City, Bethpage is a mecca for public golf featuring five 18-hole regulation golf courses, including the world-renowned Black Course.

In its July 2008 list of America's greatest golf courses, Golf Digest ranked Bethpage Black #26 overall, #6 in the state of New York, #6 of America's 50 toughest courses, and #5 in its list of America's greatest public golf courses. It is also the top-ranked course in the Golf Digest list that is operated by a governmental entity.



THE ORIGINAL CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE



Typically comprised of two 18-hole courses (River and Meadow Valleys) Blackwolf Run returned to its original single-course configuration for the 2012 U.S. Women's Open. During the championship, the players competed on the Original Championship Course — the same one that made Blackwolf Run famous more than 20 years ago.

Featuring new grasses, new sand and contouring in all the bunkers and renovated greens, the Original Championship Course comprises holes 10-18 of the Meadow Valleys course and holes 1-4 and 14-18 of the River course.

It's a course unlike any in America. The perfect stage for one of golf's greatest majors.



Professionals and amateurs of all skill levels can experience a day of golf like no other on the Meadow Valleys course. Described as both subtle and devilish, it winds through meadows and charges across ravines, reflecting the natural features of the Wisconsin terrain. This championship course challenges even the experts to weigh the relative advantages of distance and accuracy, though staggered tees put much of the danger out of harm's way for the average golfer.

The Meadow Valleys was ranked #60 in Golf Digest's ranking of America's 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses for 2017/2018.



Pete Dye designed one of the best golf courses in America on rich land once known by the Winnebagos and Algonquins for exceptional fishing and hunting. Intimidating to the professional, fair and dramatic for the amateur, this "beauty of the beast" measures 7,404 from the back tees with a slope of 151. Target landing areas, strategic bunkering, large undulating greens, and water or gorges on 14 of the 18 holes characterize the challenge of this championship course. The playing values of the River course are a match for its natural beauty.

In its brief existence, the River course has quickly earned a reputation as being among the country's very best. Ranking #15 in Golf Digest's 2017/2018 America's 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses and #19 in GolfWeek's 2017 Best Resort Courses. GOLF Magazine says this course "must be considered the nation's finest public-access course of modern times."

The Donald Ross Memorial is, in essence, a "greatest hits" compilation - selecting from some of the designer's best-known holes from the most renowned courses in his portfolio to create an unforgettable golf course. Acting on pure inspiration, the journey to select classic Ross-designed holes that would merge with Boyne Highlands' unique terrain would ultimately require countless miles of exploration - and years of dedicated effort.

In an effort to ensure authenticity, yardage for most of the replica holes - and elevation changes from tees to greens - is identical to the original. And while fairway roll and contours may differ slightly, the course looks,

Although it was originally designed to sit behind the dunes, Dye's wife suggested raising the entire course to allow players unobstructed views of Kiawah's beautiful Atlantic coastline from every hole. This improved view, however, made the course substantially more demanding as it also exposed it to the area's brisk and unpredictable sea breezes. The Ocean has the highest combination of Slope Rating (155) and Course Rating (79.6) in America.

Named in honor of Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee celebration, the third championship course at the Home of Golf, the Jubilee is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous Links. Built in 1897, it was originally intended for use by ladies and beginners; however, after seeing its prime golfing location between the New Course and the sea, the Jubilee was converted to a championship layout in 1988.

Created on a narrow strip of land between the sea and the New Course, the raised tees provide great views but also expose golfers to prevalent winds, which sweep in from the bay. Any golfer visiting St Andrews should play at least one round of golf on the challenging Jubilee Course.





Boasting undulating fairways and challenging greens, the New Course is a classic test of Links golf. The New Course, often referred to as the local's favorite, is tighter and the dense gorse and swathes present a prettier golf course. If located anywhere else, away from the looming shadow of the iconic Old Course, this golf course would certainly hold a higher reputation.

Many of the University of St Andrews Golf Team matches are played over the New Course. It would be a real disappointment to visit St Andrews and not play the New.
